

## RECOMMENDATION

### **Strong Neighborhoods Program (SNI)**

The Redevelopment Agency (RDA) spent \$105 million on the SNI neighborhoods deemed to be within the SNI "areas." These "areas" represent roughly a third of San Jose. The SNI program is another example of a program that was started with "extra money" the City had in the early 2000's. The current budget proposal allocates \$585,721 from the general fund to support a scaled down SNI program. I propose using all of these monies for specific code enforcement issues throughout the City of San Jose. At one time the City had 19 code enforcement officers; now we have 2.5. If we use this funding for code enforcement, we could increase the number of code officers to at least 8 code officers.
