## RECOMMENDATION

Rezone all public school parcels from their current designation to the PQP (Public/Quasi-Public) designation.

## BACKGROUND

There should be an interest in retaining land for schools in San Jose. Selling land for uses other than PQP could be detrimental. Historically the conversion of school property to other uses like housing has been problematic in San Jose leading to school overcrowding which impacts surrounding neighborhoods. I would suggest starting with all public schools and consider private schools as well.
