RECOMMENDATION

Schedule a City Council Study Session in September or October to analyze reports and recommendations prepared by SPUR San Jose.

BACKGROUND

SPUR has produced several reports containing suggestions for San Jose. Rather than letting these reports sit on a shelf, I think a council study session discussing their suggestions with city staff would be valuable. City Council and staff may leverage the expertise of SPUR to discuss which suggestions would be good policy. I would expect to have SPUR and city staff be the presenters.
